At long last, we are thrilled to go on our field trip to Underwood Family Farms.

This is an annual tradition, and we are beyond elated to be able to visit the farm this school year!

As we organize and prepare, here are a few things to know.

When: Friday, January 23rd, 2026

Where: Underwood Family Farms – 3370 Sunset Valley Rd., Moorpark, CA. 93021

Schedule: *(This is a rough schedule of our day at the farm. Times may vary slightly.)*

- 🍁 10:00 a.m. – Arrive at the Farm
- 🍁 10:30 a.m. – Vegetable Show
- 🍁 11:00 a.m. – Tractor Ride/Vegetable Picking
- 🍁 11:30 a.m. – Lunch *(Sack Lunch Time!)*
- 🍁 12:00 p.m. – Farm Animal Show
- 🍁 12:30 p.m. – Feeding/Visiting Farm Animals
- 🍁 1:30 p.m. – Leave Farm

What to bring/wear:

- 🍁 Sack Lunch *(Parent & Child)*, Water Bottle, & Car Seat/Booster *(If you're riding with a friend.)*
- 🍁 Long Pants, Closed-toe Shoes, & a Hat. *(We will be in full sun while picking vegetables.)*

Questions you might have:

The trip is on Friday; can families come on Tuesday/Thursday?

- 🍁 Yes, all are welcome to come to the farm. Please be sure to fill out and return the Field Trip Permission Form. **Permission slips are due on Friday, January 16th.**

Will preschool be available for children not participating in the trip?

- 🍁 Yes, this is a big outing for our kiddos, so the majority of the Rm 1, 2, and 3 teaching teams will attend the trip to support the students and families, but we will have a couple of teachers on campus for the kiddos who don't go.

Wait, there's more, turn the page over.

If a parent can't attend, can a child still attend?

- 🍁 Yes, children are welcome to ride along with friends in the cars of Parent Driver-Chaperones.

I'm willing to drive my child and others. How do I sign up?

- 🍁 Each classroom will have a sign-up clipboard for parents willing to drive teachers & students.

If I'm only driving my child, do I have to meet at the preschool?

- 🍁 No, families that drive only their child are encouraged to meet at and leave the farm without coming to the preschool. We prefer that only those driving other students meet at the preschool to reduce traffic in our parking lot. However, be sure to check in/out with Mr. Tim at the farm.

Can siblings come on the farm trip?

- 🍁 No, the preschool field trip policy prohibits siblings (*both older and younger*) from joining us. This policy helps reduce distractions for the chaperones and teachers, ensuring that our preschool students are the sole focus of our outings.

Does this trip count for MVP?

- 🍁 Yes, every hour on our trip will count toward your MVP total for the year, including driving.

Will there be afternoon preschool available post-trip?

- 🍁 No, our Rm 1, 2, and 3 preschool days will conclude with our return from the farm. This is a huge outing for our little friends; from experience, we have found it best to end our day a little earlier. *If your student is riding along with a friend, we would ask that a parent/guardian be available to pick them up by 3 p.m.*

NOTE TO DRIVER-CHAPERONES:

Please read through and submit all necessary paperwork to the preschool office, including a copy of your driver's license and current insurance card. *We will be happy to make photocopies in the office.* All our teachers/staff will ride in a PCS school van and meet the families at the farm. Driver chaperones should arrive by 8:30 a.m. on the day of the trip so we can arrange car seats and double-check everything before leaving campus. We will be leaving campus by 9:00 a.m.
